

ASSOCIATE-PROFESSOR-LEVEL POSITION (TENURE-TRACK) IN
VETERINARY EPIDEMIOLOGY

Information for Application

1. Affiliation: Joint Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Yamaguchi University
2. Departments: Pathogenic and Preventive Veterinary Science
3. Background: Yamaguchi University is inviting applications for an associate-professor-level position at the Joint Faculty of Veterinary Medicine. The appointee is expected to start her/his academic and educational activities at Yamaguchi University.
4. Contract term: Five years
Midterm evaluation will be conducted on the 3rd year.
There will be evaluations at 5th years after the appointment. If the outcome of the evaluation indicates that the appointee has made promising or significant research, he/she will be promoted to the status of tenure position.
5. Number of positions: 1
6. Research field: Veterinary epidemiology. Particularly, the field of the on-site study of epidemic is desirable.
7. Qualifications: Applicants must have a Ph.D degree which was obtained within the past 10 years, and be highly competent in conducting research in areas related to veterinary epidemiology.
They must have the ability to take responsibility for education and research in the field of prevention of epidemics in undergraduate courses. Applicants must also be enthusiastic about education and research in their field.
* Adoption standard of Joint Faculty of Veterinary Medicine:
8. Treatment: Annual salary follows the employment rule of Yamaguchi University.
9. Submission deadline: Applications must be received no later than 14th September 2012.
10. Applicants must submit the following items:
 - (1) A CV (including current address, telephone number, e-mail address and photograph).
 - (2) A list of candidate's research activities and accomplishments in reverse chronological order according to the following categories:
 - (a) Reviewed books,
 - (b) Reviewed journal publications,
 - (c) Reviewed conference publications,
 - (d) Others (such as patents and research grants).

- (3) Reprints, in principle, of publications (In the case of e-journal, a hard copies are possible).
- (4) A summary of their main research activities to date (up to 1,000 words).
- (5) Plans of their research and educational activities during the term of contract (up to 1,000words each).
- (6) A list of contributions to and activities in academic societies such as editorship of international journals, membership of conference program committees, educational activities, and awards received.
- (7) When there is a recommender, a recommendation book.

11. Selection process: The search committee will evaluate the candidates' expertise, research activities. Candidates who pass the documentary examination will be asked to give a talk on their research and attend an interview at Yamaguchi University, in which the search committee will ask him/her to present his/her research activities together with a five-year research plan in Japanese or English. In this case, we assist a part of travel expenses to attend the presentation. The search committee may contact referees to ask for detailed information about the candidates. The evaluation procedure will be strictly impartial, but the evaluation of each applicant will not be released after the appointment is made.
12. Japanese language proficiency is welcomed though not required. However, by the midterm evaluation, sufficient Japanese language proficiency to carry out ordinary university activities will be expected.
13. The appointee will receive start-up funding from the university in the first two financial years after the appointment.
