

Tenure-track Faculty Position in Neuroscience

Yamaguchi University Graduate School of Medicine invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track faculty position, at the rank of Assistant Professor. Desirable areas of research interest include, but are not limited to, neuroscience for glial biology and developmental neurobiology. Applicants should hold an PhD (or equivalent), less than 10 years experience beyond their terminal degree, and well-developed communication skill in English or Japanese. Start-up packages including laboratory space will be provided to a successful candidate. The individual filling this position will be expected to establish her/his own research as an independent PI, as well as develop collaborative research within the Department and the University. If successful as tenure-track faculty, this position will be converted to tenure within 5 years upon approval by the tenure and promotion review committee.

Yamaguchi University Graduate School of Medicine is located on the Kogushi campus in Ube-City, Yamaguchi Japan. Salary will be commensurate with experience according to the University's regulations. Application package consisting of following documents will be received until February 27, 2013. The preferred starting date is April 1st, 2013.
